Baptism Washes Away Sins and Saves

- Acts 22:16: 16 And now what are you waiting for? Get up, be baptized and wash your sins away, calling on his name.
- 1 Peter 3:21: 21 and this water symbolizes baptism that now saves you also — not the removal of dirt from the body but the pledge of a good conscience toward God. It saves you by the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
